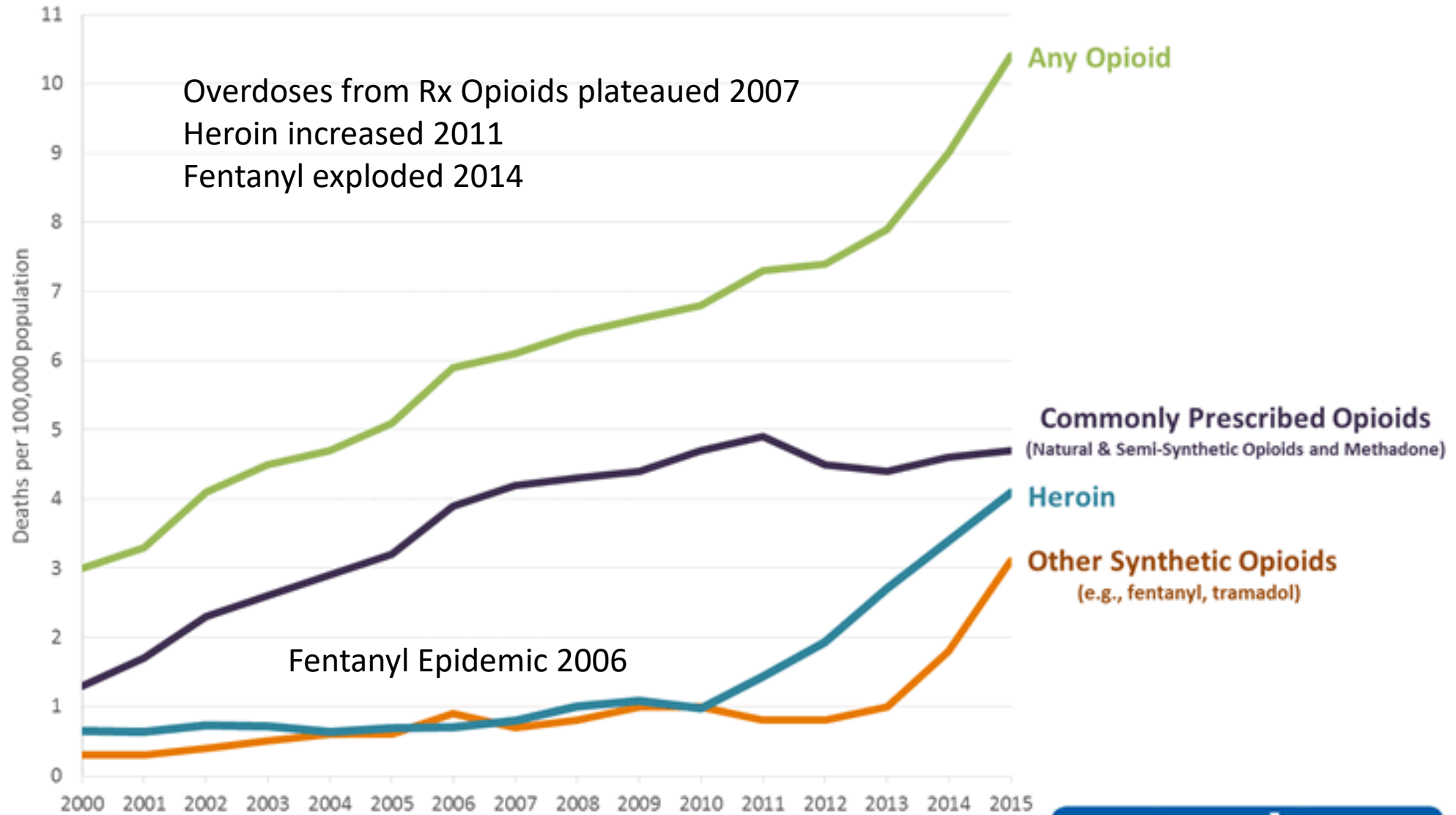

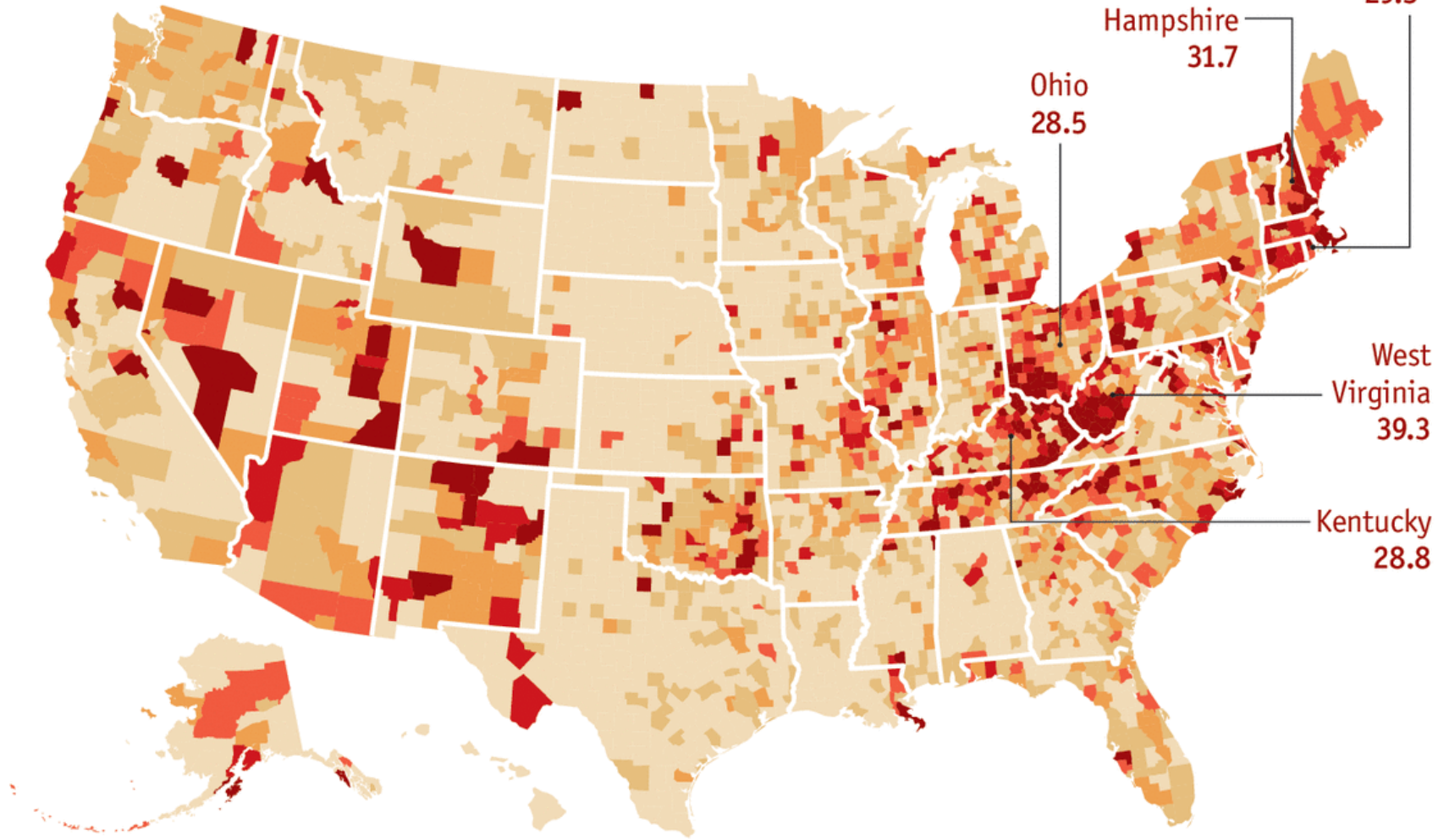
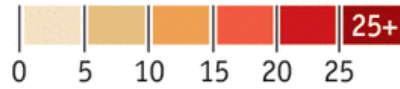

By county, 2015

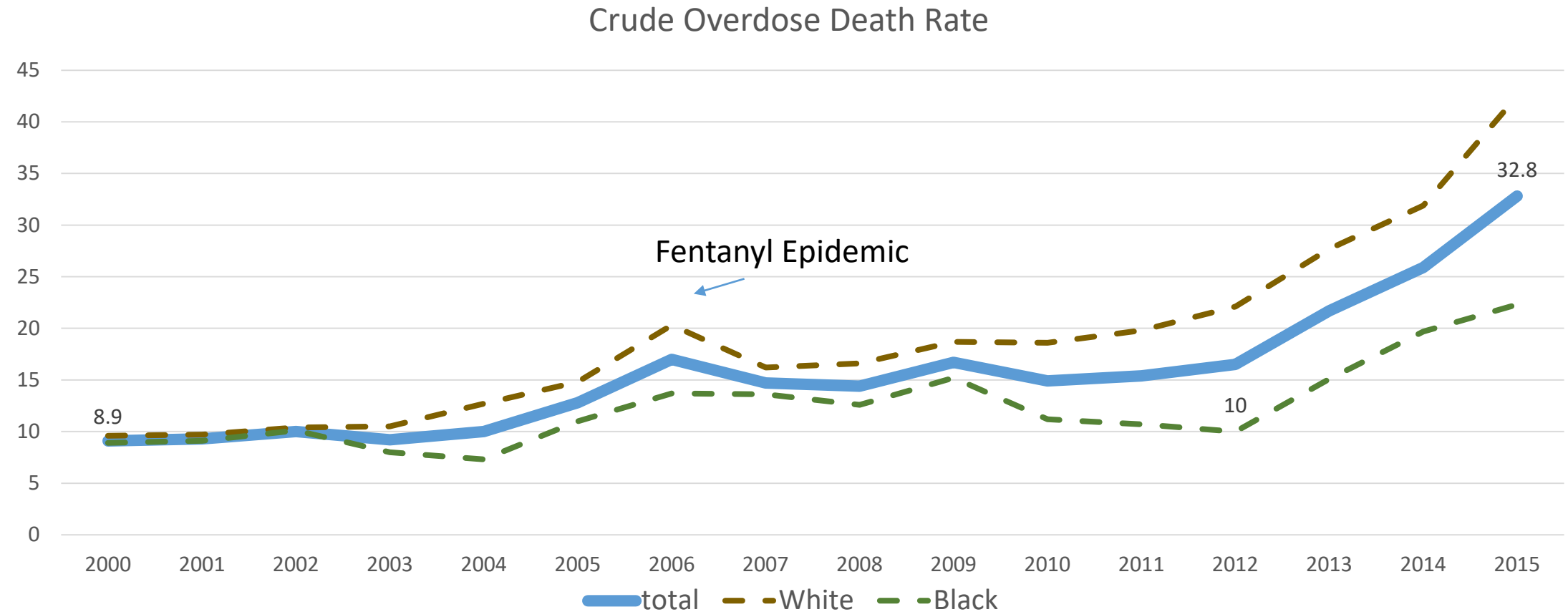
Per 100,000 population

vary by county

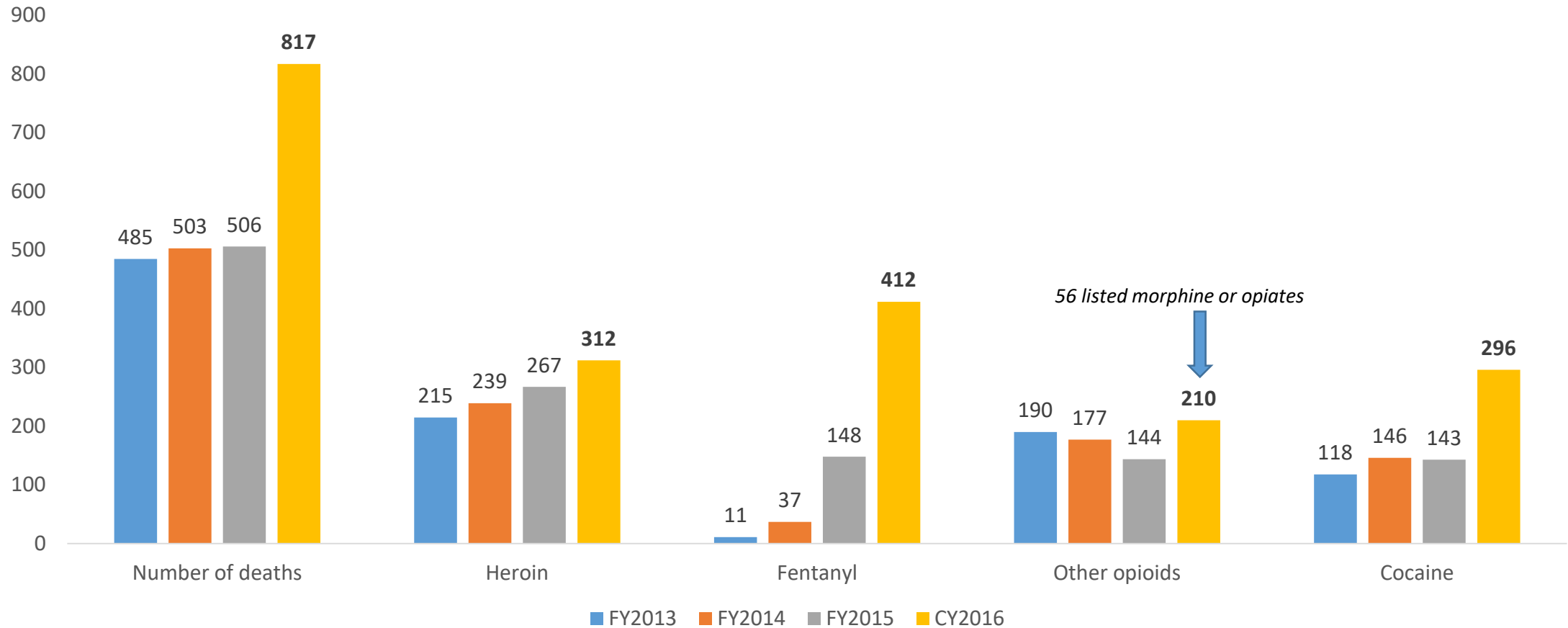

Drug Overdose Deaths per 100,000 residents for Wayne County, total population and by race



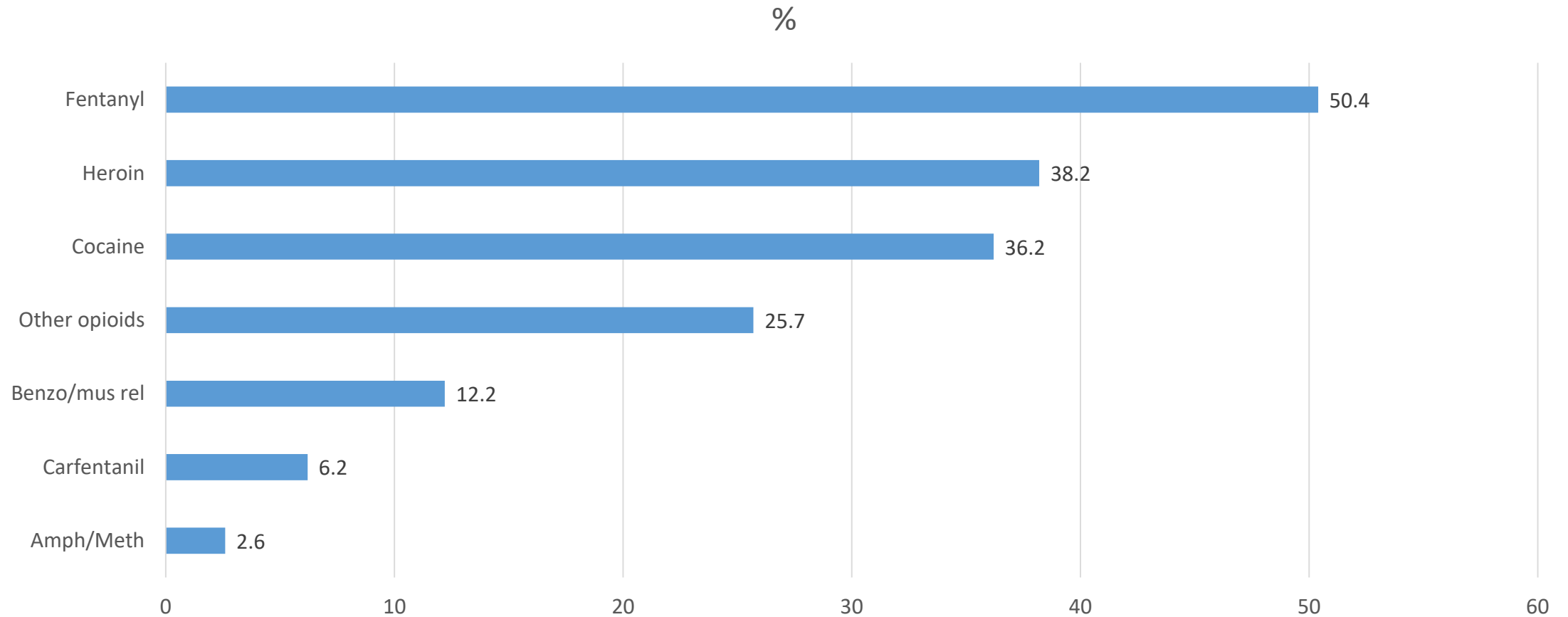

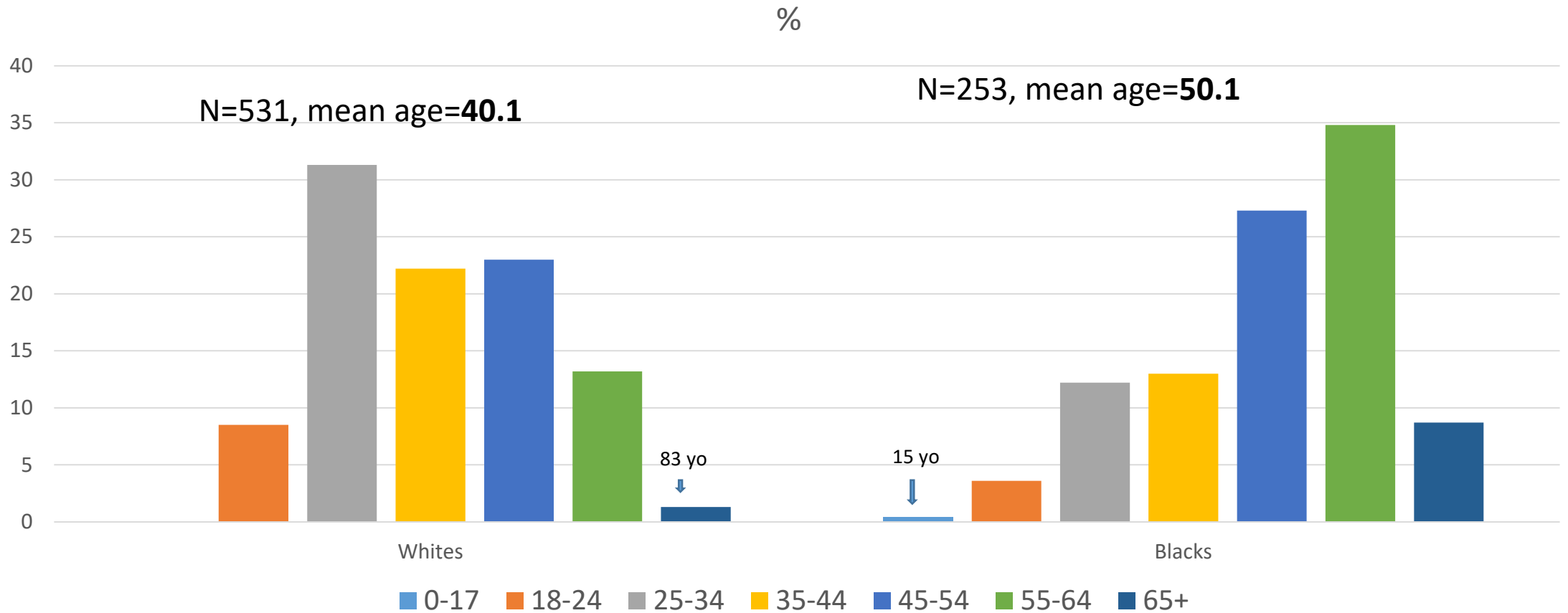
Percentage of 817 deaths caused by select classes of drugs (95.2% ruled accidental) in 2016



Fentanyl includes fentanyl and its analogs

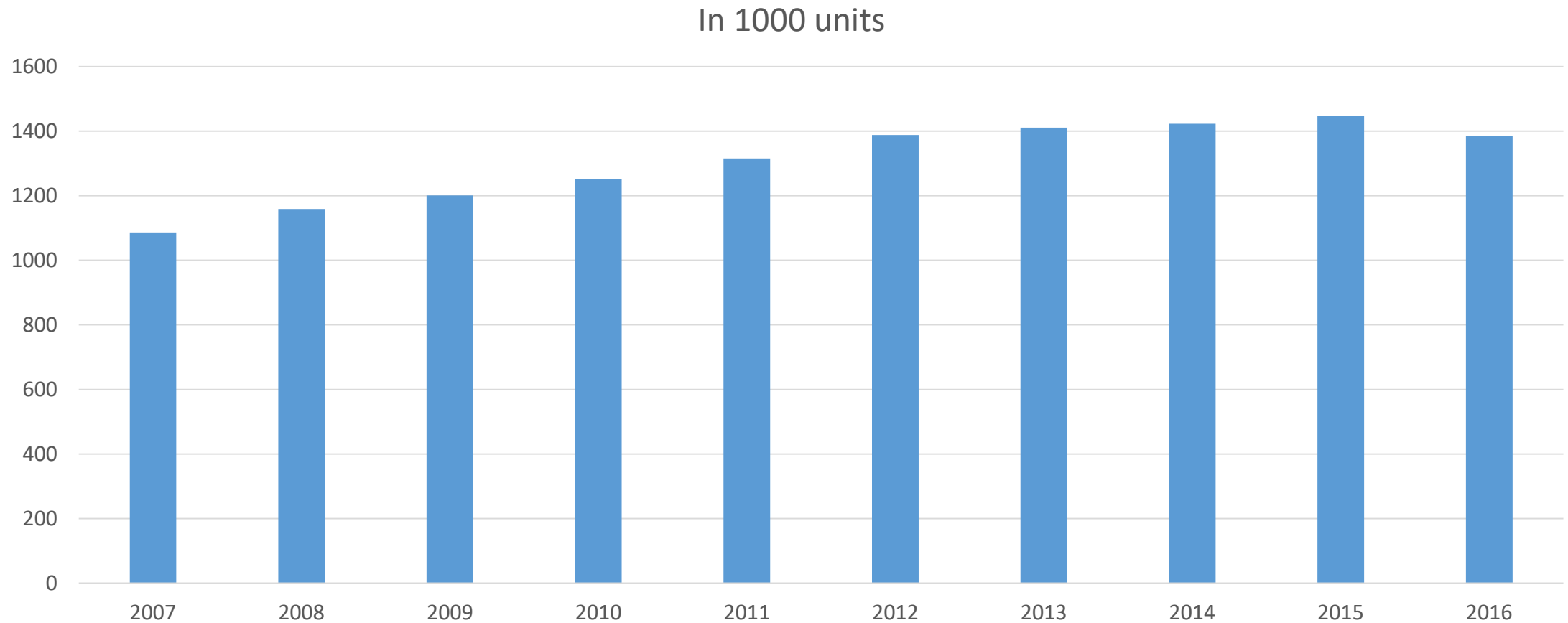
